PLUS 1% FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM

The PLUS 1% program is inexpensive, easy to implement and endeavors to accomplish the following goals:

- 1. Encourage Biblical proportionate giving.
- 2. Increase annual member contributions.



Why Engage the Plus 1% Program?

Per contributing member giving in the SELC District is 2.5% of annual personal income. If each contributing member increased by 1 % of annual income, the average per member would rise to 3.5% ... an overall increase of 40%. Translated into dollars, a 1% increase by only three members would be:

Statistics indicate 33% of church members in the U.S. are involved in worship attendance and financial support. One third of an average congregation will at least consider a 1% increase. Economic factors or personal circumstances may reduce the response of those increasing to 20%. The budget impact would nevertheless still be considerable. A \$200,000 budget increased by 20% equals \$240,000.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The financial secretary should prepare an "Annual Financial Analysis of Contributions" indicating weekly giving amounts of contributing units. See sample attached.
- 2. Include the attached Plus 1% Form and Financial Analysis of Contributions together with the annual financial statements mailed to contributing members.
- 3. Sermons and Bible studies about proportionate giving prior to the mailing as well as bulletin/newsletter information regarding the Plus 1% challenge are essential.

WARNING

Do not include the church budget. Such data may shift the focus away from proportionate giving to need giving.
