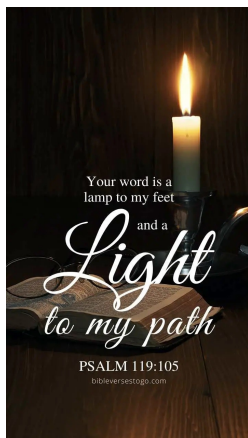

Closing Thoughts The 119th Psalm

Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a
light unto my path

These memorable words some of us may have learned already in Sunday School come from the longest chapter in the Bible, a remarkable *acrostic psalm* consisting of exactly 22 sets of 8 lines or verses, each set beginning with a succeeding letter of the Hebrew alphabet. Sadly, for whatever reason some of us rarely, if ever, spend God's gift of time in devotion reflecting on the poetic content of this inspired artistic gem (even if doing so entails more than one sitting!) thus missing out on possibly otherwise hidden scriptural blessings just waiting to be revealed especially to us Christian pilgrims during the second half of this fast fleeting year of grace 2024.

Those who *do* make an effort to pray **Psalm 119** in its entirety will immediately find a host of *synonyms* for the Hebrew term **Torah** or written Word of God or widely instructive law of God many of which also connote rich overtones of **Gospel comfort**. Speaking of God's Servant-Messiah as the "Word made flesh," the New Testament unavoidably *fixates* on our *singularly righteous Brother-Savior Jesus*. Because of Him Mosaic *commandments* and other obligatory *precepts* contextually converge with the Spirit's countless pan-biblical *assured promises* of needed forgiveness.

Thus our anonymous writer's repeated references to *statutes* and *testimonies* also call to mind for our gracious Lord's baptized believing *new covenant* Church familiar self-authenticating "**I AM's**" that the Messiah has indeed come in the person of His and Mary's Son. **Jesus Christ** is and forever remains this severely troubled world's only necessarily perfectly obedient "**Law-Keeper and Penalty-Payer**." As our innocently crucified and victoriously risen and, yes, also mercifully returning ever-living **Lord**, in the words of His post-ascension apostle Paul, He has become for each of us "our wisdom, righteousness, sanctification and redemption!" **To Him belongs the glory forever and ever!**
